Individual players in the industries may also initiate action in FERC by submitting proposed revisions to rates, terms and conditions of service; filing a complaint alleging violations with FERC statutes or orders; or submitting applications for a license to build and operate a hydroelectric plant, or a permit or certificate for a new pipeline. This panel will illustrate the various processes by which FERC regulates the energy industries in light of the specific interests and objectives of a fictitious company. The panel will also highlight the changes in the processes due to EPAct 2005, as well as, illustrate the effective use of the resources at FERC to facilitate the FERC practice.
